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	JOINT STIPULATION AND ORDER CLARIFYING SCOPE OF CLASS - 1 CASE NO. 2:18-cv-928 MJP			

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The parties request that the Court clarify that the Bond Hearing Class includes individuals who were determined to have a credible fear of torture, not just individuals who were determined to have a credible fear of persecution and who otherwise meet the criteria for class membership. *See* ECF 102.

The parties request this Order to clarify Defendants obligations pursuant to the preliminary injunction entered by this Court (as partially stayed by the Ninth Circuit).

The Court hereby CLARIFIES that the Bond Hearing Class includes individuals who otherwise satisfy the requirements for class membership but were determined to have a credible fear of torture, rather than only individuals determined to have a credible fear of persecution. Accordingly, the preliminary injunction in this case (as partially stayed by the Ninth Circuit), applies to these individuals.
